NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CHANGE IN HOURS

Our top priority is the health and well-being of our patients, families, staff and community. In this unprecedented time, we are deeply committed to keeping everyone safe.

In light of the evolving pandemic and out of an abundance of caution, we have decided to limit our practice hours for the next two weeks. Starting Monday, we will be open from 11am till 5pm Monday through Friday to meet your urgent eye care needs. We believe that this adjustment will allow us to more effectively evaluate this dynamic situation and assist in following the CDC's guidance on social separation. If you have an appointment scheduled with us this week, our office will be in touch to help reschedule your appointment.

Dr. Neuenfeldt WILL be on call in the event of an emergency. Should you require urgent care, please call our office as you normally would and Maggie will be able to assist you. If you need to order contact lenses to last you through this crisis, please contact our office. Our staff will consult with Dr. Luke or Dr. Bob to mail you your needed supplies.

To maintain proper social distancing, we are implementing several additional measures to ensure the safety of our patients and team members.

Effective Monday March 23rd all office doors will be locked, and we ask that when you arrive for your urgent appointment to please call the office and we will advise when it is time to enter the office. You will receive further instructions upon entering the office for your health and safety.

We did not make this decision lightly. A great deal of care, research and planning guided our decision. We will continue to evaluate the situation as it evolves and determine on a biweekly basis when it is appropriate for us to return to our normal business hours.

Again, please understand that we are making this decision with the health and well-being of our patients, our families, our team and our community in mind.
